The Problem

In order to launch OpenJustice, DOJ was spending countless hours digging data out of legacy systems (Police RMS, SharePoint, ect.)

Why does data publication come at the expense of improving digital services?

Open data **works** when it helps our society make sense of complex problems.

Open data **is sustainable** when it makes data production dramatically easier for people in government, not harder.

Screendoor is a platform that transforms how government delivers digital services, allowing them to become open by default.
