Advocacy

- Exchange with politicians and public administrations at all federal levels and provide them with information and knowledge
- Consultation statements/feedback
- Taking part in “participation processes” by public administrations
- Campaigning in relevant popular votes
- Monitoring implementation of legislation (e.g. open by default at federal and cantonal level), “creating data on open data”
- Monitoring legislative procedure on all federal levels
- Collaboration with other stakeholders engaged for our priorities

- Expanded political network
- Parliamentary Interventions
- Depending on the canton, adapt and improve existing legislation, and advocate for new legislation
- Aware/enabled political actors
- Laws enabling using data for good (e.g. Open by default)
- Swiss Government supporting Public Interest Tech projects

A legal and political framework is in place enabling the efficient provision, governance and use of (open) government and corporate data in the public interest.
